

Fiddlers Dream – Special Stipends

In keeping with the NTTDS stated purpose –

“To develop and promote among the general public a better understanding and appreciation of American folk dancing, its music, its roots and influences, and related folklore (hereinafter referred to as American Folk Dancing).

From time to time the NTTDS Board of Directors may vote to award up to three (3) Special Stipends for individuals to attend Fiddlers Dream who

- 1) may have extensive experience to offer as a musician, caller or dancer or
- 2) may show signs of being a budding child prodigy or
- 3) is a member in good standing who is experiencing financial hardship or health challenge or
- 4) may meet some other criterion the NTTDS Board deems reasonable and appropriate

The NTTDS Board may vote to extend an award that covers either 50% or 100% of the package for registration, on-site stay and on-site meals.

Members may submit an essay (maximum of about ½ page) to the NTTDS Board, making the case for themselves or another, including complete contact information. After the first year of incorporation, the NTTDS Board will consider any submissions, make a decision and inform all individuals of the decisions 28 days prior to the start of the event.
